## **ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICATION AT SCHOOL**

If your child needs to have medication (Epi-pens, inhalers, or oral medication) administered at school, it is critical that you complete the proper form and have it signed by your child's physician to allow us to administer the medication. This form is available through the office, and must be completed each year. Please contact Mrs. Bowers, for a form.

We are a Nut Alert School: In our school we have a number of students who are extremely sensitive to peanuts and tree nuts. The resultant anaphylactic reaction can be so severe it can be life threatening. We shall make every effort to NOT have peanuts and/or tree nuts in our school. In addition to peanut butter, we would like to remind families that soy butter, also sold as WOW Butter, is not permitted at school. Though the product is peanut free, it may activate an allergic response in students that are triggered through their sense of smell. This is a recommendation made by the DDSB and the Durham Region Health Department. Thank you for your co-operation

**Student Verification Forms – Are they up to Date?** Student Verification Forms are completed online. Please make necessary changes (e.g., work numbers, cell phone numbers, email addresses, emergency contact information, medical information, etc.). It is critical that the school data base is accurate in order to effectively communicate, and in case of an emergency.

**Student Accident Insurance:** In accordance with the Education Act, we do make Student Accident Insurance Policy available to families. Participation in the program is voluntary, and costs are paid for by the parents/guardians. **Lunch Time at Lincoln**: Our lunch hour runs from 11:15am-12:10pm. Students remain in their own classrooms to eat from 11:15am-11:35am. Students are supervised by lunchroom supervisors and/or teaching staff. Students are outside for lunch recess from 11:35am to 12:10pm, so it is important to be prepared for the weather. **No Dogs Please:** In order to ensure that the school yard is a place of physical, emotional, and psychological safety for all students, dogs are not permitted on school property – even if leashed. If you have any questions, please contact the office.
